

## **Commitment to emissions reduction and climate neutrality.**

Línea Directa Group has developed and published its first decarbonization plan for 2030 within its Non-Financial Information and Sustainability Statement. This plan responds to Royal Decree 214/2025, which establishes the regulatory framework for measuring, reducing, and offsetting the carbon footprint, as well as for developing CO<sub>2</sub> removal projects.

This instrument aligns with the goals of the Paris Agreement by utilizing the SBTi emissions modeling tool. This tool sets a reduction trajectory aimed at limiting the global temperature rise to 1.5°C and achieving climate neutrality (Net Zero) by 2050, while also incorporating an interim target for 2030 into the roadmap.

In this context, the organization is making progress in reducing emissions by addressing the scopes that cover greenhouse gas emissions resulting from its operational management. The baseline year for the target is 2022—the year the calculation methodology was stabilized—and the reporting scope has remained unchanged since then. Direct and indirect emissions under corporate management totaled 897.20 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, comprising Scope 1 (471.00 tCO<sub>2</sub>e) and Scope 2 (426.20 tCO<sub>2</sub>e).

The 2030 target entails an overall reduction of approximately 48.19%, including the complete elimination of Scope 2 emissions through the use of renewable electricity.

To meet these commitments, Línea Directa has made significant efforts in recent years regarding efficiency and investment in renewable energy sources. The courses of action implemented include:

- Significant improvement in energy efficiency.
- Promotion of electricity self-generation.
- Use of renewable energy in the energy mix.
- Raising staff awareness and engagement.

Continuous replacement of equipment with more efficient technologies. Under the new regulatory framework, Línea Directa continues to drive transparency and continuous improvement. The Línea Directa Group provides for the periodic review of these plans and reinforces its public commitment to the fight against climate change.

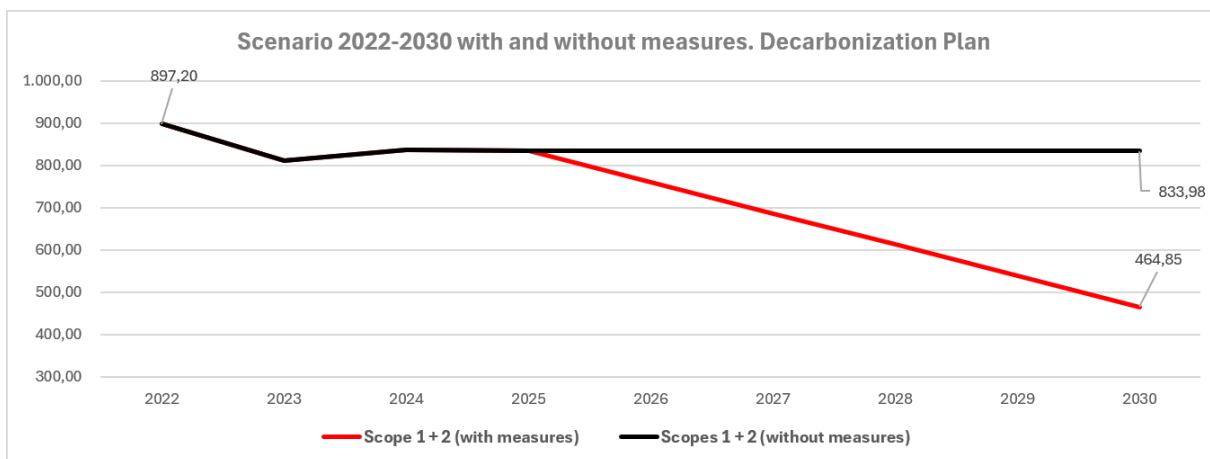
**Commitment to emissions reduction and climate neutrality.**

The 2030 Decarbonization Plan approved by the Línea Directa Group aligns with the timeframe set by the Paris Agreement and the SBTi standard (a 42% reduction by 2030). Through implementation measures over the coming years, the company expects to achieve a 48.19% reduction in emissions by 2030 compared to 2022 levels.

The primary opportunity for improvement lies in Scope 2, where the goal is to reduce emissions to zero.

The approved target—which exceeds the 42% minimum—provides a buffer against potential unforeseen events beyond the company's control that could lead to unexpected increases in emissions.

The proposed scenario and the projection for 2030 are outlined below.
